Edsby is RI Baker's program used to report GRADES and ATTENDANCE to parents.




Invitations for Edsby have been emailed. Thank you to all the Parents that have already set up their accounts! If prompted when signing up, the School Code is Pallisersd

Hello from the Learning Commons,



WOW another school year is about to end. This year in the library we have read many wonderful novels and enjoyed various picture books based on a variety of topics.



Thank you to Noah, Cara, Lance and Frankie for working in the canteen this year. We appreciate your dedication and the service you offered to staff and students.








