Enrolment and Classes

- We currently have 260 students enrolled, which is more than originally projected.
- Each grade has three classes, with larger class sizes averaging 30 or more students.

Staffing Updates

- New staff members include:
 - Mr. Havinga (from Jees)
 - Ms. Serbu
 - Mrs. McGee (School Counsellor)
 - Ms. Easthope (CASA classroom teacher)
 - Megan Hamilton (former school counsellor)
- The CASA program is designed to support student mental health. The current focus is on literacy and numeracy, with students set to transition back in January and new students entering the program. Early feedback has been very positive.

School Updates

• Jason expressed appreciation to our trustees for their support.

- There is interest in changing the school's name from *R.I. Baker Middle School* to *R.I. Baker School*.
- The school is pursuing the addition of an electronic sign at the front of the school to improve communication.
- Jason highlighted the importance of Edsby as our parent communication and reporting platform, and reiterated how grade reporting works through the system.

Library and Learning Resources

- The school library has been reviewed, with no inappropriate materials found.
- Teachers are also checking classroom collections, and nothing inappropriate has surfaced to date.
- The government is restructuring the program, and we are inventorying classroom books accordingly.

Job Action and Activities

- Due to uncertainty around job action, some extracurriculars (such as cross-country) have started, while others will wait until October.
- This precaution is to minimize disruption should job action occur.
